**Members who are eligible to serve on Council must:**

- Be on the Register of Dental Hygienists (Practising **or** Non-Practising).
- Be in good standing on the date of the election.
- Have a minimum of two years practice of dental hygiene in Canada.

**CDHM Council Role and Responsibilities:**

- Attending all Council meetings and the AGM. Council meetings will be held 4 to 5 times per year at a time mutually agreeable to all.
- Providing governance and leadership to the College through administration of the Act, Regulations and By-Laws.
- Exercising the rights, powers and privileges of the College on behalf of the College.
- Establishing and monitoring registration and continuing competency requirements.
- Appointing and overseeing the work of the committees established.
- Establishing and monitoring Regulations, By-Laws, Standards of Practice and Competencies.
- Providing direction to the Registrar.
