Management of periodontal diseases

- Become familiar with the 2017 AAP/EFP Classification
- Review non-surgical treatment: effectiveness and limitations
- Learn about surgical treatment: indications and outcomes
- Review maintenance and sharpening of periodontal instruments (manual and power-driven)

SEMINAR #2

Drugs and systemic diseases associated with the periodontium

- Explore the adjunctive use of medications in the management of periodontal disease, including chlorhexidine and antibiotics
- Discuss the drugs associated with gingival enlargement
