# **Restorative Techniques** Refresher for the **Dental Hygienist**

# June 1-5, 2025

Participants of this course will review the necessary knowledge and skills to place technically-sound and clinically acceptable dental restorations using a variety of restorative materials. In preparation for the course, registrants must complete a self-study using the required University of Manitoba, School of Dental Hygiene lab manual and the recommended textbook followed by successfully completing a written online assessment with a passing grade of 70%. The registrant will attend the preclinical sessions where they will practice placing restorations using a typodont and mannikin set up. Upon successful completion of pre-clinical competency assessments, the registrant will proceed to clinical sessions where they will place dental restorations within a live patient-care setting. Successful completion of clinical competency assessments will provide the registrant with a Certificate of Completion.

## Learning Objectives

- describe common restorative materials and their properties
- Select and perform appropriate isolation strategies and moisture control
- Understand and demonstrate esthetic considerations in material selection and anatomy reformation
- Select and use appropriate armamentarium including matrix systems, instrumentation, and retraction techniques
- Place intermediary restorative materials
- Place permanent restorations in primary and permanent teeth
- Perform occlusal adjustment
- Perform finishing and polishing of restorations
